MEDICAL SERVICES	Medical services will be provided during the competition.																		
COVID 19	Besides the FIG medical guidelines for the particular event, FIG also requires all the participants to follow the standard precautions. The FIG requires all participants, judges and officials to take standard precautionary measures, such as frequent hand-washing, wearing masks or face coverings at all times and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres whenever possible. The only situation in which the safety distance does not have to be respected is when a coach provides assistance (catch, lead, spotting) during an athlete's performance. This phase must be kept as short as possible and the assisting person is obliged to wear a mask throughout.																		

	Gymnasts do not need to wear a mask or face covering while they are performing at the training venue or on the FOP and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres whenever possible.
VISA	<p>Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Ukrainian Embassy or Consulate in your country whether a visa is required for your travel to Ukraine. The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that a written request is made to the LOC by 15 April 2022.</p> <p>The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city to which the visa application support letter should be sent.</p>
INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy).</p> <p>Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance.</p> <p>The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the visiting federation's own expense as follows: 50 EURO per person/day.</p>
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members (see exception herein below).</p> <p>The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by 5 May 2022.</p>
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	Local transport from/to the airport or central railway station in Kyiv will be arranged free of charge by the LOC for all delegations participating in the Ukrainian International Cup 2022.
ACCOMMODATION	<p>Accommodation will be arranged free of charge by the LOC for all delegations participating in the Ukrainian International Cup 2022. (The delegation must not exceed 12 persons)</p> <p>Accommodation for additional members of delegations can be provided at the expense of the visiting National Federation, at a rate of 70 EURO per person per day. FINAL BANQUET	<p>Every delegation participating in the “Ukraine International Cup 2022” will be provided with five banquet tickets free of charge.</p> <p>If the delegation needs additional tickets to the banquet, the charge per ticket will be 50 EURO. The payment is made on the day of the arrival to the LOC.</p>																						
JUDGES AND JURIES	<p>All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event.</p> <p>The Organizing Member Federation will apply a fine of Euro 500 per missing judge if a federation fails to bring the required number of judges.</p>
