<b>RULES AND REGULATIONS</b>	<p>The competition will be organized under the following FIG rules, as valid in the year of the competition, except for any deviation mentioned in the World Challenge Cup Rules in Artistic Gymnastics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Statutes</li> <li>• Code of Ethics</li> <li>• Code of Conduct</li> <li>• Technical Regulations</li> <li>• License Rules</li> <li>• Code of Points, relevant Newsletters, and Helpdesk</li> <li>• General Judges' Rules</li> <li>• Specific Judges' Rules for Artistic Gymnastics</li> <li>• Medical Organization of FIG Competitions and Events</li> <li>• Anti-Doping Rules</li> <li>• FIG Framework for Safeguarding Athletes and other Participants from Harassment and abuse in Sport during Events</li> <li>• Media Rules</li> <li>• Apparatus Norms</li> <li>• Rules for Advertising and Publicity</li> <li>• Accreditation Rules</li> <li>• Rules for Awards Ceremonies</li> </ul> <p>and subsequent decisions of the FIG Executive Committee</p> <p>Federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the FIG (e.g. annual membership fees, unpaid invoices, etc.) or the LOC may not be allowed to participate in this World Challenge Cup.</p> <p>Federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the Local Organizing Committee by the given deadline in these Directives may still have the possibility to participate, but the LOC will not guarantee the hotel booking, meals and local transportation.</p>																																
<b>FEDERATIONS INVITED</b>	<p>The Organizing member federation may invite FIG member federations in good standing at their discretion, but must invite at least all Member Federations which had:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– gymnasts ranked 1-50 per apparatus in the Qualifications at the last World Championships preceding the respective World Challenge Cup Series.</li> </ul>																																
<b>PARTICIPATION AND FIG LICENSE</b>	<p>Only senior gymnasts in good standing with the correct age and holding a valid FIG License may participate. The Organizing Committee will be responsible for checking the validity of the gymnasts' licenses. No gymnasts will be accepted without a valid FIG License at the deadline of the Nominative Registration. These on-line registrations will only be accepted from FIG Gymnastics Member Federations. <b>ENTRY FEES</b>	<p>The non-reimbursable cost for the Entry Fee (approved by the FIG) is of 40 EUR per gymnast. The payment of the entry fee must accompany the Definitive registration on 16 April 2022 at the very latest.</p>								
<b>ACCREDITATION</b>	<p>At the time of arrival, every delegation will be brought to the Accreditation centre in the Hotel where they will receive a welcome package including all relevant information and the accreditations, which will allow access into the training and competition halls. The accreditation is personal and non-transferable and must be used at all times. In case of loss, the Head of Competition must be contacted immediately.</p> <p>The participants which will not book their arrangements through the OC, the price for accreditation is 100 EUR per person and include also local transportation and farewell dinner.</p> <p>In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the safeguarding Officer operations plan upon accreditation.</p>								
<b>COMPETITION FORMAT</b>	<p>The World Challenge Cup competitions consist of: Qualifications and Apparatus Finals.</p> <p><u>Qualifications:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Participation is limited to 2 gymnasts per NF on each apparatus.</li> <li>▪ In addition, the Organizing Member Federation is allowed to name a max. of 4 "hors concours" competitors (from the Organizing Member Federation) in Women's Artistic Gymnastics and a max. of 4 "hors concours" competitors (from the Organizing Member Federation) in Men's Artistic Gymnastics for a total of 8 "hors concours" gymnasts (i.e. while one "hors concours" gymnast can compete on more than one apparatus, not more than one "hors concours" gymnast can compete on an apparatus). They must be named at the time of the closing of the nominative registration and they cannot qualify for the Finals. They are not eligible to receive World Challenge Cup points, they must not appear on the official results lists and they will have to start first at every apparatus.</li> <li>▪ FIG Apparatus Finals rules will be applied for vault.</li> </ul>								

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules as set up in the Technical Regulations, Section 2, shall be applied.</li> </ul> <p><u>Finals:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ The best eight gymnasts per apparatus from the qualifications qualify for the Finals</li> <li>▪ Participation is limited to 2 gymnasts per NF on each apparatus.</li> <li>▪ In addition to the 8 finalists, if the Organizing Member Federation is not represented in the Finals (men or women), it has the right of maximum 2 wild cards as follows (1 man and 1 woman gymnast only at one apparatus each).</li> <li>▪ These “Wild Card Gymnasts” must have participated at the respective apparatus in the qualification.</li> <li>▪ “Wild Card Gymnasts” will receive medals and prize money.</li> <li>▪ FIG Apparatus Finals rules will be applied for vault.</li> <li>▪ In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules as set up in the Technical Regulations, Section 2, shall be applied.</li> </ul>																					
<b>DRAWING OF LOTS</b>	<p>The gymnasts' drawing of lots for all FIG World Challenge Cup events will take place on site, during the orientation meeting or during a separate function organized for that purpose with invitation to all participating NFs.</p> <p>At the time of the nominative registration, the apparatus on which the gymnast will compete must be mentioned. Modifications can be made until accreditation. Gymnast may be changed and apparatus can be added as long as 2 gymnasts/apparatus/NF is respected.</p>

<b>MEDICAL SERVICES</b>	A MD will be present at all the official trainings and competition and will comply with the medical assistance requirements.
<b>COVID 19</b>	<p>Besides the FIG medical guidelines for the particular event, FIG also requires all the participants to follow the standard precautions.</p> <p>The FIG requires all participants, judges and officials to take standard precautionary measures, such as frequent hand-washing, wearing masks or face coverings at all times and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres whenever possible.</p> <p>The only situation in which the safety distance does not have to be respected is when a coach provides assistance (catch, lead, spotting) during an athlete's performance. This phase must be kept as short as possible and the assisting person is obliged to wear a mask throughout.</p> <p>Gymnasts do not need to wear a mask or face covering while they are performing at the training venue or on the FOP and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres whenever possible.</p> <p>We will inform you of the latest Covid-related policies one week before competition. If new policies will be imposed after that date, we will inform the teams as soon as they become known to the LOC.</p>

<b>DOPING CONTROLS</b>	The Organizing Member Federation will provide at its own charge a minimum of 6 doping controls, 3 for Women and 3 for Men.
<b>VISA</b>	<p>Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Slovenian Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Slovenia. The Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before 16 May 2022 to the LOC. Please note that should the delegation would require the invitation letter in the material form the non - reimbursable postage fee (according to the invoice of DHL) will be applied.</p> <p>The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.</p>
<b>INSURANCE</b>	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. **WINNER OF THE ANNUAL WORLD CHALLENGE CUP SERIES**

The winner of the annual World Challenge Cup Series is the gymnast with the highest number of points on the respective apparatus after the last event of the year, taking into consideration the best results (maximum 3), regardless of the number of competitions the athletes participated in.

Should there be a tie after the last competition, it will be broken as follows:

- a. The ranks of the max. three (3) counting exercises will be added and the gymnast with the lowest total prevails.

Note: in case of a tie in the ranks to determine the three counting exercises, the exercises with the highest final scores will prevail.
