SPECIFIC RULES FOR PARKOUR

November 2019 / June 2020

The specific rules listed below apply only to this discipline.

ARTICLE 1 JUDGES' COURSE

One course will be held in 2019 and last 3 days. (Arrival and departure days not included). The Course will include a practical examination on video.

1.1 2019 International Judges' Course

- Each Federation will be permitted to send a maximum of one (1) judge to the course
- Category 1 may be achieved at this course and the 2020 Intercontinental Judges' Course only

1.2 Examination Retest

A judge who wishes to achieve a higher score or reverse a failed result may retest at another course in 2021, in either case the judge must attend the entire course again and take the examination.

- With successful repetition of the course and examination, all judges will be awarded the category as indicated by the standards achieved on the best examination.

ARTICLE 2 EXAMINATION

2.1 Summary of Evaluation Method for Examination

This Summary of Evaluation Methods for Examination is provisional and will be confirmed by the Parkour Commission after completion of the 2019 examination.

Freestyle Practical Examination

	Maximum = 100%
The calculation of score for each routine consists of the following steps: 1. Determine the deviation of each judge's individual evaluation from expert score 2. Assignment of a percentage based on the deviation from the expert score	The final score will be the average percentage from all exercises.
Part 1- Component Judging (18 scores for 18 video exercises) 9 men's exercises with 1 component each scored from 0-10 (steps by 0.5) 9 women's exercises with 1 component each scored from 0-10 (steps by 0.5)	9 men's exercises- components (3 E, 3 C, 3 D) 9 women's exercises- components (3 E, 3 C, 3 D)
Part 2- Exercise Judging (30 scores for 10 video exercises) 5 men's exercises with 3 components scored from 0-10 (steps by 0.5) 5 women's exercises with 3 components scored from 0-10 (steps by 0.5)	15 scores (3E, 3C, 3D per exercise) for men's exercises 15 scores (3E, 3C, 3D per exercise) for women's exercises
48 total scores to be given by each judge from 0-10 28 total video exercises	

Maximum time for evaluation and listing of required components scores is 60 seconds per video in Part 1 and 90 seconds per video in Part 2.

2.2 Examination Evaluation Scale (Final) – standards and categories

The percentage scores (average of all components) required for the examination evaluation (below) will be fixed by the Commission after the examination is completed.

Standard	%	Category
Excellent	85% – 100%	Category 1
Very Good	75% – 84.99%	Category 2
Good	65% – 74.99%	Category 3
Pass	55% – 64.99%	Category 4
Unsatisfactory (Fail)	0.00% – 54.99%	Fail

All categories will be awarded through 2024.

Note: A judge must pass the Freestyle Examination to also be certified for Parkour Speed.

ARTICLE 3 CATEGORY 1

3.1 Category 1 Judge Qualification and Quota

The PKC must assure that enough Category 1 judges are selected to fulfill the necessary responsibilities required during the cycle.

- Category 1 will be no more than 20% of the total participants in the 2019 course.
- All judges that worked at 2 competitions in 2019 (World Cups &/or WUG) will be awarded Category 1 through 2024, in addition to the ones above.
- All remaining Category 1 judges will come from the 2021 Intercontinental Judges' Course.

3.2 Category 1 Selection Freestyle- World Championships

For 2020/2021 World Championships: only Category 1s from federations that participated in the 2019 World Cup Series or WUG may judge the freestyle competitions. All others will be drawn to positions for the Speed competitions.


