2022 ONLINE JUDGES' TESTS DIRECTIVES

Version 1 - 20 December 2021

Overview

The Executive Committee approved changing the traditional in-person judges' courses and examinations to an online format for the start of the 2022-2024 cycle. The Covid-19 pandemic has posed a great threat to hosting in-person courses. The president of the FIG Anti-doping, Medical and Scientific Commission recommended the avoidance of gathering dozens of judges into meeting rooms over several days all over the world. Travel restrictions and the financial stakes were also major factors in the decision.

The FIG has contracted STS Tests to develop and oversee the online testing for the 2022-2024 Codes of Points. This is the same company that has provided the FIG online judges' educational platform over several years.

The Technical Committees have been working diligently to provide online educational materials that will be made available through the new STS educational platform. STS Tests, with materials approved by each TC, will administer online testing with major similarities to the examinations of the past cycles.

More information regarding the online tests and brevet qualification for the 2022-2024 cycle can be found in the 2022-2024 General Judges' Rules and the 2022-2024 Specific Judges' Rules for each discipline. These are now available on the FIG website.

All brevet judges of the 2017-2021 cycle that pass the online exam will retain their international brevet. They will be able to judge competitions starting 01.01.2022 <u>using the 2022- 2024 CoP</u> until their online test results are released in February-April, depending on the test date. The 2022-2024 brevet will become active upon passing the online test.


Educational Materials

Content from the 2017-2021 cycle (except Parkour) has been available for current brevet judges, through the use of their login and password. This can be accessed through: www.web-sts.com/.

For new judges, every federation will be supplied with a login and password directly from the FIG (sent to the main federation email address on file with the FIG). Links to STS Educational websites will be sent to new brevet candidates through their NFs. This access can be sent only to new judges that need to prepare for the tests.

The IRCOS competition video library in STS (shown as Competition Videos) are very helpful when practice judging for the 2022-2024 Code of Points. Reminder, all <u>other</u> content from this 2017-2020 STS educational platform is from the present cycle (2017-2020) and will NOT be part of the examination preparation.

If a current brevet judge (2017-2021) has any problem with their access, they can go to the STS webpage and use the "Contact Us" link to request a new password and/or login. (see example below)



Access to the new STS educational platform for the 2022-2024 cycle (Test preparation) will open in late December for some disciplines and January for others. As soon as the TC content is available, it will be posted. This content will include TC lecture presentations (web-based PPTs with video clips), practice routines/runs (for PK) with analysis, library of IRCOS competition videos and other learning tools. This access will also be available through: www.web-sts.com/

The same login and password for the 2017-2020 STS educational platform will work for the new 2022-2024 educational platform. The 2017-2020 platform will convert to the 2022-2024 platform as soon as possible. The Code of Points dates will be shown on each platform, so the conversion and newer format will be apparent.

Educational presentations by the TCs in STS will be in the four FIG official languages (with Parkour in English and French only). English may be available before the other languages, but all preparation content will be available, at the latest, two weeks before the first test in a respective discipline.

FIG Judges' Registration

The fee for each judge to participate in the online Official Test is CHF150. This also includes the educational platform access and Practice Test. Each NF will be billed directly by the FIG.

NFs must use the FIG online database to register their judges. The login and password for the Practice Test and Official Test will be available for all judges shortly after the registration process is completed by each respective NF.

<u>For all World Cups and World Championships starting after 31 March 2022</u>, please note that a judges' brevet for the 2022-2024 cycle will be required to register and judge. Therefore, <u>no judge</u> can be registered at the provisional and definitive stages for these competitions after 31 March without the new brevet certification. It is ok to put "0" judges during registration for these cases and make the correction once the new brevets have been confirmed.


Registration will be open for PK and ACRO in December and all others in January.

The national federations register the judges with current brevets (2017-2021) and place them in the desired test through the online Sport Database. All deadlines as shown in the Test Schedule must be respected. Judges' must be enrolled in the online test (dates & time zones) where they will be taking the test. Updated passports will be needed later, before they can receive their final results. The database will provide the online access information, login = their judge ID number and a password (also shown in the database). This information will need to be sent to each judge SEPARATELY so

each judge may individually access the Practice Test and Official Test. The login and password for the STS Educational platform will NOT give access to the Practice Test or Official Test.

The national federations may also register a maximum of 10 new brevet judges in each discipline. For these new judges, a new profile will need to be created in the Sport Database, and as soon as possible, while respecting the deadlines set out in the Test Schedule. The FIG will need to validate (as quickly as possible) these new judges before tests (ID numbers for dates & time zones) can be selected by the NF for each judge. Then the database will provide the online access information, login = their judge ID number and a password. This information will need to be sent to each judge SEPARATELY so each judge may access the Practice Test and Official Test. The login and password for the STS Educational platform will NOT give access to the Practice Test or Official Test.

Test Stages

For candidates there are two stages for the STS Tests system:

- 1) Practice Tests that familiarize candidates with the login, video display quality and data entry input for their discipline.
- 2) Official Test

Practice Test

One week before each Official Test, candidates will have the opportunity to enter the STS Tests site to practice and prepare for the Official Test. The goal is to have all candidates for a specific test on the STS Tests platform to test their hardware and connection, and at the same time, allow STS to confirm all their systems are working optimally.

All candidates should login 10-15 minutes before their sessions. The Practice Test is just a sample to get familiar with the input screens and no answers or results will be shown. The Practice Test can be completed in approximately 30 minutes.

Once the Practice Test is over, candidates will have access to it and may repeat taking it until the day of the Official Test. If a judge is unable to attend the practice session or has connection issues, they should contact STS through their website "Contact Us".

Official Test

All candidates should login 10-15 minutes before their sessions. More information on the format and breaks (if any) will be specified in the next edition of the Test Directives. One important feature to mention is the "Submit" button. Candidates have two choices when they complete their input: 1) hit the submit button and immediately move to the next routine or 2) wait until time expires and anything entered will be automatically captured as their result.

Final Candidate Results

Tests will be administered on a 'pass/fail' basis. Fina results will be sent to each NF once rechecked by the FIG office and confirmed by the respective TC President.

Judging Input Screens for the Tests

The input screen examples will be available in the next edition of the Test Directives after approval by the TC Presidents.

Hardware / WiFi Recommendations and Connection Issues

Do not use a mobile phone for the Practice Test or Official Test. The tests can run best on PCs, MACs and full-size tablets. A mouse or stylus is recommended, but not required.

The Chrome browser is recommended for the STS Educational websites, Practice Tests and Official Tests.

If you lose connection, the test will resume from the same place you last had connection, however, you only have a 20-minute window to resume the test. If necessary, a candidate can restart their test on a different device and/or a different WiFi or hardwire network.
